Learn to skate classes focus on the skills of skating forward, backward, turning, stopping, balancing, spinning and jumping. Younger skaters learn to skate through activities and play. Professional coaches oversee these sessions with help from our Program Assistants. Skaters earn badges for various stages of accomplishment. Parents do not accompany their children on the ice. Group size varies according to requirements of registration. **Children under 3 may be accepted upon coaching assessment.**

APPROPRIATE DRESS & EQUIPMENT

Skates are not provided. For **CANskate** it is recommended that you purchase leather lace-up skates rather than moulded skates. Please do not purchase the style of skate that has one strap across the in-step as the skater is unable to stand straight. Figure skates are required for the Figure **CANskate** classes. We recommend the following shops for skate purchases. They carry new and used skates and their staff is trained in fitting skates.

Skating HELMETS are MANDATORY (Hockey helmets are recommended)

Mittens are required. **Layered clothing** is recommended as bulky snowsuits can hinder movement

GENERAL PROGRAM INFORMATION

In the event that skating sessions are cancelled due to arena availability or circumstances beyond the control of the Gateway Skating Club (e.g. Mechanical failure) there shall be no abatement of skating and/or instruction fees or refund thereof, except at the sole discretion of the Gateway Skating Club. If the skater registered is in any way disruptive during skating lessons causing other skaters to be held back from a positive learning experience the skater will be asked to withdraw from the class and a partial credit of registration fees will be given.
