The Junior STARSkate program is a stepping point between CanSkate and figure skating and focuses on the skills of edges, spins, jumps and dance through **45-minute on-ice sessions** supplemented by **25 minute off-ice sessions**. Skaters registering should have skills equivalent to a Stage 3 CanSkate program.

On ice sessions are conducted by Professional NCCP Coaches in a small group format with 5-6 skaters in a group. **Figure skates are required**. We recommend **Pro-Skate** (9212-51 Ave or 170 St & 111 Ave) or **United Cycle** (10323-78 Ave) for skate purchases.

Off-ice sessions focus on Fitness, Flexibility and Stretching. **Equipment Required: Running shoes, Yoga Mat or Towel & Water Bottle.**
