Dates: Sept 10 – Dec 7 (NO class on Sept 24)

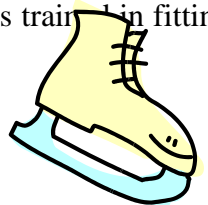
EQUIPMENT

Skates are not provided. It is recommended that you purchase leather lace-up skates rather than moulded skates. Please do not purchase the style of skate that has one strap across the in-step as the skater is unable to stand straight. We recommend the following shops for skate purchases. They carry new and used skates and their staff is trained in fitting skates.

United Cycle 10323-78 Ave

Skating HELMETS are recommended. Layered clothing is recommended as bulky ski pants and jackets can hinder movement.
